The Junior Naturalist Program at the Busch Wildlife Sanctuary is a curriculum based project geared towards children ages 9 to 14. This program offers its participants a one-of-a-kind opportunity to become involved with the conservation efforts of the Busch Wildlife Sanctuary.

Junior Naturalists must be between the ages of 9 and 14 and pay associated due of \$200.00 per weeklong session to cover expense of shirts, manuals, activity supplies and other operational costs. Dues must be paid, in full, one week prior to the first day of each session.

The program is from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. The Junior Naturalist Program is limited to 15 participants per session. Children must be picked up by 5:00pm. Children not picked up on time will be subject to an additional charge of \$5.00 per fifteen minutes after the pick up time.

The Junior Naturalist Program is very popular, so if the enrollment is filled to capacity at the time your application is submitted, your child will be placed on a waiting list. As spaces open up, your child will be eligible to enter the program in the order your application was received. After your child completes each session, you may re-register your child for subsequent sessions. These applications will be placed at the end of the waiting list and processed on a first come, first served basis.

Junior Naturalist will experience all facets of the Busch Wildlife Sanctuary from animal care and food preparations, to native plant gardening, learn about Florida's wildlife, presenting educational programs, working with wild animals, creating displays, and much more!

## **Risk Factors**

Volunteering at the Busch Wildlife Sanctuary can be a very rewarding experience. Volunteers will have the opportunity to meet other people with similar interests, learn about nature and wildlife, help injured animals, and assist the Sanctuary in teaching visitors about Florida's natural resources.

Even though many safety features have been installed in the animal enclosures, working with wild animals can be dangerous. The Sanctuary's staff will do their best to help volunteers learn about working with these types of animals. However, because volunteers often work in close proximity to live animals, there is always the potential to be injured, bitten, or scratched. Simply being aware of this fact, using common sense, taking proper care as you work, and asking staff for assistance when you have a question will go a long way towards preventing any injuries.

Alrhough most of the permanent residence at the Sanctuary have received vaccinations, the injured animal patients that are brough in for care have not. By volunteering to work at the Busch Wildlife Sanctuary, you must understand that you are accepting certain risks. It is impossible for the Sanctuary to guarantee your safety while you are volunteering you time. We welcome volunteers to donate their time, but they must do so at their own risk!

Volunteers must sign the Certification and the Waiver and Release below before they can begin volunteering their time. Parental signature is also required if the volunteer is under 18 years of age.

## Certification

I am volunteering with knowledge of the dangers involved, and I agree to accept any and all risks of injury and/pr death.

I agree to hold harmless the Busch Wildlife Sanctuary, the Loxahatchee River Environmental Control District as well as their directos, officers, agents, employees, and members, who through negligence or carelessness, might otherwise be liable to me.

I understand and agree that this Waiver and Release is binding on my heirs, assigns and legal representatives.
