This twenty-acre sanctuary exists to support the rehabilitation and release of animals brought into our wildlife rehab center and care for those that cannot be returned to their natural habitats.

Wildlife Rescue and Rehabilitation

The Sanctuary's animal rehabilitation center provides emergency and ongoing medical care to 6,000 sick, injured, and orphaned animals each year. We can accept over 50 animals each day. Nearly 90% of the animals treated here suffered from human-related injuries.

Release

We celebrate the release of many rehabilitated animals back into natural habitats across Palm Beach County. Animals with injuries too severe to return to the wild are residents of the Sanctuary.

Awareness and Education

Our animal residents are ambassadors to educate and inspire people to engage in local conservation efforts. We want to raise an active community of people who cherish, enjoy, and protect the wildlife and our natural environment.


